# HERO PILOT'S SHOPPING CART CAREENS OUT OF CONTROL, INJURES 5

Chesley B. "Sully" Sullenberger, the hero pilot who miraculously landed a US Airways jet into the Hudson River, lost control of his shopping cart at a local supermarket last night and seriously injured five people.

Sullenberger was trying to return the cart to a shopping cart corral when it suddenly careened across the parking lot and slammed into a crowd of shoppers. Eyewitness Velveeta Lugosi said: "He had no idea how to drive that thing."

Sullenberger blamed the accident on a collision with a flock of birds, but officials at the supermarket ruled out that explanation and concluded the likely cause was operator error.

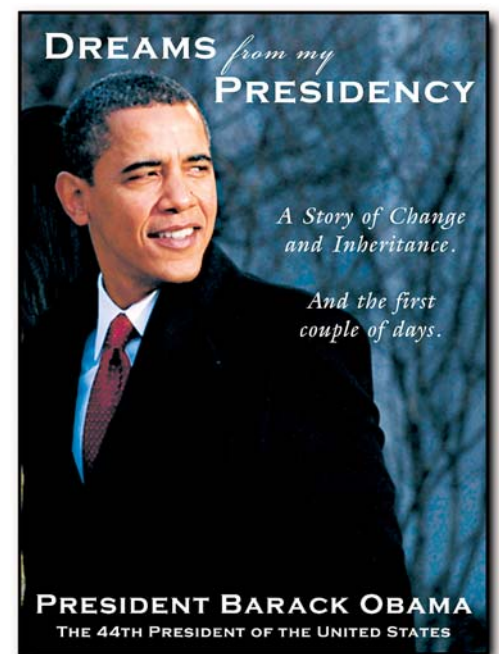
Obama said that he is taking his family on a three-week vacation to Hawaii starting tomorrow. "I'm going to learn to surf and do all the other things I never had time to do."
